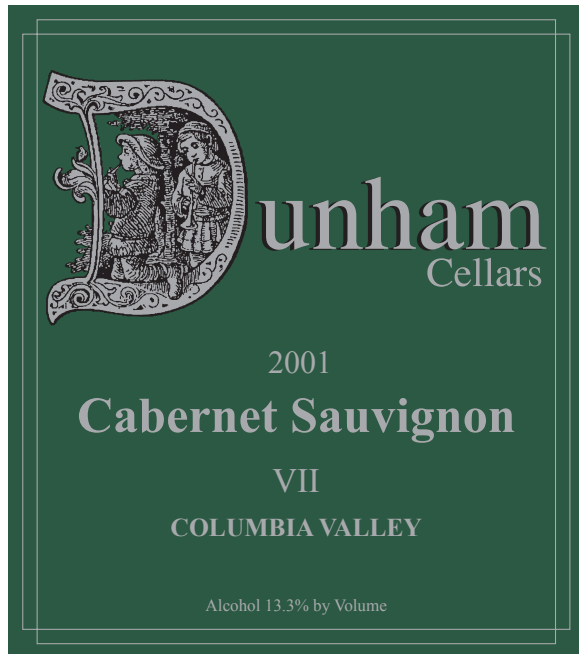


DUNHAM CELLARS | 2001 CABERNET SAUVIGNON VII
